### Rules

- The project must be lingering for at least 6 months without you working on it.
  - Activities such as pulling it out, lamenting, thinking about working on it, playing with the pieces and putting them away again, etc. do not count as working on it.
- The project must be either a quilt or bag. Other items, such as clothing or household goods, are not part of this challenge (I had to draw the line somewhere).
- You must complete the project into the final form. Items can be resized/repurposed as long as the finished project is either a quilt or a bag and has some of the original fabric/pattern. Sorry Rhonda, no cutting it up and using it as cat bed stuffing.
- Complete a **Finish What You Started** project sheet and submit it to me, along with pictures of the front/back of the quilt or the outside/inside of the bag, at:

- Each project gets points in three areas: Phase Dropped, Project Complexity, and Project Size ranging from a total of 3 points to a total of 20 points available for each project.
- The worksheet calculates the project points based on your selection in each of the areas. See the worksheet for the options for each area.
- I will keep track of the completions and points based on the submitted project sheets. At the January 2024 meeting, I will present challenge awards for:
  - Most number of completed projects by one person.
  - Most number of points by one person.
- You must complete the project during 2023 and submit the project sheet with photos to me by January 6, 2024 to be eligible for the project awards.
